Pet Policy

Note: This policy will be strictly enforced at all group-wide Rover events such as weekly and special meetings, Extravaganzas, board meetings, etc. The intention of this policy is primarily to respect the needs of all human attendees to feel safe and able to enjoy any Rover gathering. The enforcement of this policy during member-organized Rover trips and/or activities will continue to be at the discretion of the trip coordinator(s) and all trip participants.

Pets are welcome at Rover events (where permitted by the locale) but must remain on a leash that is no more than six feet long (or shorter if dictated by locale), and be held by a person who agrees to remain in control of the animal(s) at all times or restrained in a suitable manner as to not be a nuisance to others (i.e. personal pet crate, vehicle or tent).

The animal(s) will be expected to remain reasonably quiet and show no signs of aggression.

Pets will not be allowed in or near the dining area during meals; including preparation and clean-up.

Owners/handlers will be asked to remove the animal(s) or leave an organized Rover group event if this policy is not strictly followed..
